

This process requires institutions to submit their eligibility documents for review, aiming to enhance structure and accountability throughout the league.

I enjoy watching some matches of the game titles that I play. The talent in the NJCAAE is already through the roof and it gets better every year," said Broderick.



#### **Round Robin Check-in Requirement:**


No longer twenty-four (24) hours in advance.

#### No-shows:

One verified No-show in Tier 1 and Tier 2 competitions may lead to complete removal from the competition, and possibly further sanctions.

#### Tier 1 - Team Limitations:

Game titles with only two (2) players on a team are no longer limited to one (1) team for the Tier 1 - Premier Series. This means you can field as many teams as you'd like for Tier 1 competition for these game titles. Our suggestion is that each team you field in Tier 1 competition have at least one person filling a sub slot.
